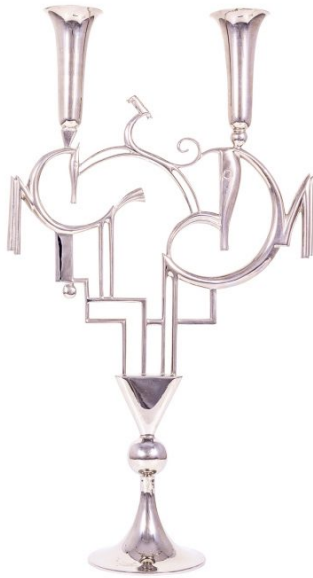




CANDLESTICK WERKSTATTE HAGENAUER CA. 1930

This two-flame candlestick is an exciting testimony to the early works with stylized, figurative representations and ornaments of the Werkstatte Hagenauer Vienna.

A sacred-looking element forms the base of the candlestick, reminiscent of a liturgical chalice. Delicate strands rise from it, which in their arrangement appear in rectangular shapes. The strict design dissolves into curved lightness towards the top. Here the viewer finds strongly stylized horses and a dog, which to discover appeals to the imagination. The design is crowned by two elongated trumpet-shaped candlesticks.

On an imaginative voyage of discovery, the candlestick's overall image allows for a wide range of interpretations.
