With their female nudes and busts, Karl and Franz Hagenauer created figurines of stunning charisma. On tiptoe and with elegantly raised leg and arms, the dancer surrenders to the rhythm. Her slender silhouette and elongated limbs emphasize her grace, and the young lady's light movements can be felt right down to the tips of her hair.

A dog joyfully prances around the figurine, which additionally expresses the irrepressible joy of life.

The graceful dancer is well documented in Hagenauer's sales catalog from 1957 and was manufactured with differently shaped plinths, whether -as here- wooden or metal.
