In the 1930s, Werkstätte Hagenauer had already a small bowl featuring an elephant family in their product range. The present, larger group of elephants, consisting of a mother elephant and a calf, joins the wonderful depictions of exotic animals and is also featured in the company's sales catalog from 1957, known as the "Zettelkatalog." We date this wooden sculpture to the second half of the 1950s. Both animals are skillfully carved and stained from precious wood. The mother elephant and the baby elephant differ slightly in color, and the female elephant has tusks made of nickel-plated brass.
