In the metal-processing workshop founded by Carl Hagenauer, artistically refined everyday objects were produced from the very beginning. His two sons Karl and Franz continued this tradition, and so, in the 1930s, Werkstätte Hagenauer featured design objects that were used as window displays in upscale retail. The elegant lady's arm with hand belongs to this group, just like, for example, lady's busts used by jewelers for the impactful presentation of rings and necklaces. These extravagant items bear the futuristic signature of Franz Hagenauer from the 1930s. Designed artistically in tune with the times and crafted with high quality, they were excellently suited for an "image transfer" in exclusive trade. Jewelers staged their precious creations on these elegant ladies' arms, idealized hands and busts, and thus, could emphasize the exclusivity of their goods.
