Popular works of the Werkstatte Hagenauer Vienna include depictions of horses created in various ways. Here, the masterful brass casting is left as a hollow body, defining the viewing side clearly. Like a spiral, the elegant horse's head emerges from the base. The thread-like arrangement of the mane accentuates the powerful dynamism of the sculpture. This continues with the elongated head pointing to the left. It creates an arrow-like overall image, which draws the spectator's attention in this predetermined direction. The focused gaze of the animal, indicated with minimalist simplicity by only two lines, also follows this direction. This effect of the sculpture is particularly well-suited for presentation in dialogue with other objects.
