The artistic design of utilitarian objects was part of Werkstatte Hagenauer's "DNA" from the very beginning on. Thus, various models of table lamps are already illustrated in the 1928 sales catalog. On a total of five pages, there you can find different bases for table lamps, be it figural representations or stylized animals.

The design of this interior accessory dates from a later period, namely the years around 1950.

Here, as well, the design captivates with no-frills and its perfect reduction of the shape: pointed ears, tapered snout and the bushy tail clearly characterize a fox. Sitting under the lampshade, it almost seems as if the little fox is resting under a treetop. Resting its overlong tail on the floor in front of it, the statuette of the fox forms a harmonious contrast with the stand and shade.
